Although not widely appreciated, economic geography – the location of economic activity - is already a critical issue for Bangladesh. It is possible to argue that due to excessive concentration, Dhaka is sinking of its own weight and dragging the rest of the country with it. This introductory discussion on the topic will present patterns in economic activity across districts and upazilas, suggest that urban development is inadequately supporting growth and poverty reduction, and explore policy approaches towards a more efficient locational distribution of economic activity. The discussion will also lay out a research program to dive further into these issues.
